WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 709.023(C), the Village of West Jefferson adopted Resolution No. 24-030 on April 1, 2024, which Resolution indicates the type and scope of services the Village of West Jefferson will provide to the territory upon annexation to the Village, and addressed any buffer requirements ("Services Resolution"), which Services Resolution was timely filed with the Madison County Board of Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, on May 21st, 2024, the Madison County Board of Commissioners approved the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, a certified copy of the annexation proceedings was provided by Madison County to the Clerk of Council of the Village of West Jefferson on May 31st, 2024; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 709.04, the Clerk of Village Council has placed before Village Council the resolution of the Madison County Board of Commissioners granting the petition, as well as the annexation petition and accompanying map/plat and legal description at this next regular meeting following the expiration of sixty (60) days from receipt by the Clerk of the same; and

WHEREAS, Village Council is authorized under Ohio Revised Code 709.04 to accept or reject the Petition for annexation at this time.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Jefferson, County of Madison, State of Ohio, with the majority of duly elected members thereof concurring as follows:

<u>Section I.</u> The proposed annexation of 45.773+/- acres from Jefferson Township, Madison County, Ohio to the Village of West Jefferson, a petition for which was filed with the Board of Commissioners, Madison County, Ohio on March 13, 2024 and approved by the Board of County Commissioners on May 21st, 2024 is hereby accepted. The petition and accompanying map/plat and legal description are attached hereto as Exhibit A, which graphically depicts and describes the territory that is the subject of the annexation.

The Clerk of Council shall provide notice of this annexation in writing, along with a copy of the map/plat/legal description, to the Board of Elections of Madison County within thirty (30) days after it becomes effective. The Clerk of Council shall do all other things with respect to the action taken by this Resolution as may be required by law.



DESCRIPTION OF 45.794 ACRES LYING EAST OF STATE ROUTE 29 AND NORTH OF U.S. 40

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Madison, Township of Jefferson, being part of Virginia Military Survey No. 3888, 10929 and 12148, and being part of a 103.260 zero tract conveyed to Thirty-Four Corp. (68%) and M 3 T Corp. (52%), by deed of record in Official Record 165, Page 2379, and all of a 1.000 zero tract conveyed to Thirty-Four Corp. (68%) and M 3 T Corp. The portion of the centerine of U.S. 40, having a bearing of South 86°33'55" West and monumented as shown hereon, is designated the "basis of bearing" for this description.

All rebar set are 5/8 inch DIA, 30 inches in length, with a red plastic cap stamped with the name "Landmark Survey".
